Church Stretton is a historic market town situated in the heart of the Shropshire Hills National Landscape. It is a major tourist centre, and leisure is a key part of the local economy alongside farming and technology. The Town Council is responsible for over 200 acres of outdoor spaces including two Local Nature Reserves which extend into the town as well as heritage assets and buildings. The population of the town and the surrounding six villages and hamlets is 4,600 and the annual budget is £0.6m.

The Town Council are looking for an additional person to enhance their Outdoor Team. Although the role will predominantly assist with general maintenance to Council owned buildings and land; this would suit someone who is happy to adapt to working both inside and out to support the many facilities we have to offer our local community. Covering the whole of the portfolio of land and building assets owned and managed by Church Stretton Town Council.

Duties include:

- To work as part of a team to ensure the care and maintenance of all Council owned / managed buildings and outdoor spaces.
- Undertaking regular checks and maintenance, paying particular attention to health and safety and enhancing the natural beauty of our market town.

Although we are looking for someone with experience in a similar role, full training will be provided and learning on the job will be a key part of the right candidates role.
