We can't avoid it, we are surrounded by risky events every day – in our homes walking up and down stairs in slippers, outdoors running for the bus, crossing the road, overtaking slow lorries – and every day we subconsciously assess the risks and then take the appropriate action.



Unfortunately, subconscious risk assessment is not sufficient for parish and town councils. At least once a year parish and town councils must address the business of 'risk'. We need to show that we are taking risk seriously by evidencing the council's thought processes, hence the creation of the council's Risk Management Policy and related risk assessments.
